### A PICTURE OF GRACE

Mr. LaGuardia was one of the most famous mayors of New York City. Before he became mayor, he was a judge at a police court. It was in the days of the Great Depression. One day they brought a trembling old man to appear before him, charged with stealing a loaf of bread. The old man said he had to do it for his family was starving. "Well. I have to punish you," said Mr. LaGuardia. "The law makes no exception and there is nothing I can do but sentence you to a fine of ten dollars." Then, he reached into his pocket and said, "Here's the ten dollars to pay your fine." ### FIRST GAVE THEMSELVES
