### SACRIFICIAL GIVING

Robert Atherton, who was raised in luxury, gave \$5,000,000 to the work of the Lord. He did not do it without sacrificial living. A letter which arrived from a missionary in China read: "Were I in England again, I would gladly live in one room, make the floor my bed, a box my chair and another my table, rather than that the heathen should perish for lack of a knowledge of Christ." Atherton followed these suggestions almost to the letter for the rest of his life. -Copied. I believe if the truth were known, very few Christians know anything about sacrificial giving.
