SEPARATION REQUIRED

Some years ago now, a power line fell down in Klamath Falls, Oregon and killed a cow. Another cow came along and touched the dead one and received a jolt that stunned her. A cat came to see things and was electrocuted upon touching the cow. Two jackrabbits received the same fate. One is reminded of the Scriptures: **“Touch not the unclean thing.”** (Read II Corinthians 6:14-17).
