WANTED: RIVERS OF LIVING WATER!

"...Jesus stood and cried saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me and drink. He that believeth on me, as the Scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. But this spake He of the Spirit which they that believe on Him should receive..." ~John 7:37-39. These are the last days and we need some strong meat for the few who are able to digest it. God always expects His people to be filled with the Holy Spirit. Did He not command us: "...be ye filled with the Spirit."? Could He have a lesser standard? I am not just being negative; merely criticizing. Just look around in our Fundamental Baptist churches and see how many truly Spirit-filled Christians you can find? One problem is many professions in our churches are false professions. Some of you will recognize the name David Otis Fuller, that strong defender of the King James Bible. He went on to Glory a few years ago. In his later years, he preached all over this land, mostly in Fundamental Baptist churches and he said he believed that at least fifty percent of the people in our churches were not saved. I believe he was right! Then, anyone with spiritual discernment can see that most of the others are certainly not Spirit filled but carnal. The Apostle says that carnal Christians are babies - some are twenty or thirty years in the Lord but still babies. Babies are cute (not when they are 20 or 30 years old), but there is nothing more selfish than a baby. He only thinks of himself. He has got to be the center of everything. Many years ago, Dr. Shelton said he took some Pastors out to dinner and also took his little daughter. She just prattled away in spite of the adults that were there. Finally, he said, "Hush, Marjorie." She replied, "But Daddy, Marjorie must speak." How true of many *baby* Christians. Dr. Ironside said, "*The carnal (baby) Christian is delightful - as long as he gets his own way!*"

The greatest need of the hour is Spirit filled believers! We will not admit it, but our churches are Laodicean - lukewarm, worldly! Revelation 3:17 says, "**Thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing...**" Oh, Yes, we have large budgets, fancy buildings, etc., but where is the Holy Spirit power? What are we accomplishing without Him? What does God say? "**...and knowest not that thou are wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked.**" How many professed believers think more of sports and TV than the Sunday or Wednesday night services. Many Fundamental Baptist churches have begun to give those services up because it is all they can do to get a handful out. Where are those whose lives have been radically changed by the Spirit of God. Doesn't the Word say, "**If any man be in Christ, he is a new creature; old things are passed away. Behold, all things are become new.**"? Spurgeon told of a new boy in Sunday School. He was from a poor neighborhood and not too bright. But he learned his memory verse, John 3:15. He recited it: "**That whosoever believeth in him should not perish but have INTERNAL life.**" Spurgeon said it was not quite right, but he had a lot of truth. I do not believe it is possible to have the Holy Spirit within and be the same old person except you go to church now and then. I challenge you to grow up, repent and ask God to help you to be done with self and to fill you with the Holy Spirit. It will cost something, but I warn you that God is not happy with carnal, worldly Christians!

YOUNG PEOPLE - STAY AWAY FROM YOGA!

Yoga, transcendental meditation, etc. are extremely dangerous. These are not simply to relax the mind, body builders, etc., but in fact they are basic elements of Hinduism. People say, well I don't get involved with the religious aspect. That is impossible! Yoga is the heart of Hinduism. It is worthless without the mantras (which are names of Hindu gods), etc. It is amazing how many public schools use yoga though it is a religious exercise. I am appalled by the number of Fundamental Baptists, including Pastors who think that yoga is all right! Some even have yoga classes in the church - how stupid or deceived can they be? Yoga is not incidental but fundamental to Hinduism; it's the means of bringing one into perfect harmony with the "Universal Divinity." While many may escape *seemingly* unharmed, others have been scarred for life. Dave Hunt testified: "I have interviewed people who became demon possessed through yoga." (*Berean Call* 8/98). Young person, shun this as you would the plague. Many ecumenical leaders believe when we do get one-world religion, it will be a combination of Christianity and Hinduism.

His speech is of no account - since he offended me. He is not a hard worker - since he offended me. He's not the man for the job - since he offended me. In fact, I'm trying to oust him - since he offended me." The truth is, our churches are full of carnal people like this except they would never acknowledge it! I would like someone to tell me how you can lead a group of people according to the Bible, without offending anyone. In fact, in all probability, he will offend or cross everyone one of them over a period of time. God says, "**Judge righteous judgment.**" Remember, He does!
