

## **HOW LATE IS IT?**

The answer to the above question is, It is very late! Dr. J.H. Brookes was a strong Fundamentalist who preached about one hundred years ago. He was a man of great perception and penned the following around 1900: "It seems more and more evident that truth is not to win the field in our day; it will have a tremendous fight to hold it's own against the ever-increasing odds with which it has to contend. *If the battle were only with the world and the devil, there would be nothing to fear; but, unhappily, the fight must be carried on principally against professed friends. Insurrection rages within the citadel, and a man's foes are those of his own household. The church itself is traitorous and the worst enemy we have to dread.* Annihilation, restoration, evolution, a mixture of Herbert Spencer, Darwin, and Jesus Christ - such is the stuff certain popular preachers are giving their hearers...Alas! Nothing is more apparent to me, than that the professing body, with its false doctrines, its worldliness, its scarcely concealed iniquities, is on the rapids just above the Falls of Niagara, and the awful abyss is just below." Writing some years later Dr. Brookes said: "The conflict between truth and error is waxing hotter on this side of the sea (in America), as it is in the mother country. Higher criticism (fountain of all modern bible versions), a denial of the inspiration of the Scriptures, future probationism, annihilationism, contempt for the atonement, ridicule of our Lord's Second Coming, even in so called evangelical churches, are pushing forward with a bolder front every day; and those who are contending earnestly for the faith once delivered unto the saints, are few and disheartened. But why should we be surprised? We are plainly told by our Lord and the Holy Spirit in the inspired writings, that in the last days there shall be difficult times, and we ought to know that just what we see around us, must be witnessed before the end shall come."

That dear man of God certainly had his hand on the pulse of the times but what would he say if he were living today? Never mind the liberals, the cults, the Catholics, etc. Look what is going on among professing Fundamental Bible believers! Many, if not a majority of Fundamentalists do not believe they can hold the inspired Word of God in their hands - they assure us with great haughtiness that "only the originals are inspired." Worldliness is rampant among those who profess faith in the crucified Son of God. Carnal and even ungodly dress is tolerated. Many fundamental churches have dropped the Sunday Evening Service or the Wednesday Prayer Meeting and in some cases both. Then, rare indeed is the Fundamental church that has a door-to-door visitation ministry or preaches on the streets. While hell is still believed, it has been somewhat softened; it really doesn't matter for it is seldom if ever preached. When one looks at the world and the professing church, he sees exactly what the Word of God predicts for the last days; read II Tim. 3:1-5, etc. However, it is not the time to give up but to stand up and be counted for Christ. Let's "**Fight the good fight of faith!**" Let us stand on and for the Word of God (there's only One, you know what it is).

I have met many people over the years, including not a few Christians, who thought that because they felt like doing something, they should do it. I have especially met many Christians who thought they should preach, but it was obvious to others they were not called. I am reminded of the man who was asked: "Can your son play the violin?" 
## YOUTH CORNER

### ALARMING POLL CONCERNING TEENS!

Here are some frightful statistics from a Barna Poll via *TBC This Week* (9/26/03).

## PREVENTING CHURCH SPLITS

This is a very serious problem among God's people and it is becoming more so with every passing day. The Word of God has the answer; the problem is many professed believers simply will not obey God. For starters listen to David: "**I will set no wicked thing before mine eyes: I hate the works of them that turn aside; and it shall not cleave to me...Whoso slandereth his neighbor, him will I cut off...He that worketh deceit shall not dwell within my house: he that telleth lies shall not tarry in my sight...**" ~Psalm 101:3-7. In the New Testament we read: "**Now I beseech you, brethren, mark them which cause divisions and offences contrary to the doctrine which ye have learned and avoid them.**" ~Romans 16:17. It says MARK THEM AND AVOID THEM. If troublemakers were denied a following, there would be no Church splits - either they would repent or be isolated! Look at II Thessalonians 3:6: "**Now we command you brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye withdraw yourselves from every brother that walketh disorderly (*without subordination*), and not after the tradition which ye received of us.**" Note, it is A COMMAND...WITHDRAW YOURSELVES... In verse 14 it says, "**If any many obey not our word by this epistle, note that man and have no company with him, that he may be ashamed.**" It says HAVE NO COMPANY with disobedient members! There would be no Church splits if God's people would just treat rebellious, self willed people as the Scriptures tell us.
