Someone said, "Why, what makes you say that, Ben?" He answered, "Cause whenever he went up North, or went on a journey to the springs, he always talked about it for a long time; he packed his bags and got ready. He said, **"I am the way, the truth and the life; no man cometh unto the Father but by me."** ~John 14:6. If you want the answer to the things above, there is only one place you can find them - Christ! NEWS YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT

SEPARATING THE MEN FROM THE BOYS!

We are fast approaching the time when, in America, it will cost something to stand up for our faith. The following are excerpted from *Legal Alert*, July 2004:

"Hate crimes" laws are getting closer. In Canada it is now a "hate crime" to criticize homosexual activity in any fashion. Broadcasters are forbidden to air any critical discussion of homosexuality. A pastor in Sweden was arrested *in his church* for reading Bible verses on homosexuality.

In Montana, a pro-homosexual marriage group has threatened to sue a church for gathering signatures against such conduct before and after church services.

More and more public schools are supportive of homosexual rights. A Missouri school honored a lesbian as teacher of the year despite protests of the Christian community. Schools in Connecticut are posting pro-homosexual literature inside classrooms. A Christian woman has been cited for opening her home to feed small groups of homeless as invited guests.

THE IMMODEST DRESS PROBLEM.

Religion Today (6/12/04) states: "The president of the American Decency Association says pastors around the U.S. have been voicing concerns about immodest dress they see in their churches. Bill Johnson says the church needs to counter this trend primarily because Christians worship a holy God. He said, 'As we come to the house of God on a weekly basis [we need to recognize] that we are there primarily to bring glory and honor to His name. Distractions caused by immodest dress can detract from a person's worship experience. The true Christian would not knowingly contribute to the downfall of another.'" Editor: We have preached and written on this serious topic before. The worst thing about it is many Fundamental pastors will not deal with it. I don't hear many complaining about it! In a recent *Challenge* we quoted Rick Flanders: "There is a problem with immodesty in the more strict fundamentalist churches too. Christian women and girls are letting the trendy stores decide how they will dress. Too much skin is allowed to show on the top by low necklines and wide armholes, and in the middle by short tops and sagging bottoms, and at the bottom by short skirts, short culottes and just plain shorts. Clothes worn by too many believers are too tight and otherwise revealing. There is too much nakedness among believers. "God commands Christian women to dress modestly and He tells preachers to deal with it. He told preacher to tell the women that they **"adorn themselves in modest (appropriate) apparel."**

IN THE NAME OF CHRIST AND EVANGELISM.

Evangelist Greg Laurie held a "Southern California Harvest" at Anaheim Stadium. It featured "Extreme athletes (who) flew from ramp to ramp during a motocross demo, BMX riders and skateboarders exhibited tricks on a Vert Ramp, and crowds danced to music from artists as diverse as Skillet to Fernando Ortega...The evening crusade program called 'A Night of Worship' featured a message from Laurie, known for communicating the Gospel in a fresh, culturally relevant way." -*Religion Today* (7/15/04). This makes me sick! I think it must make God sick also; read Rev. 3:16, I John 2:15-17. They say they're just repackaging the Gospel. I don't think God appreciates it when you wrap the Gospel up in a bucket of garbage! I am sure the *culturally relevant gospel* had no place for sin, hell or repentance. That sort of show will get a crowd and even some *decisions*, but I doubt that anybody was really saved with a *culturally relevant gospel*.

SUPREME COURT PROTECTS PORNOGRAPHY!

"The estimated number of pornographic websites is 4.2 million and the number of individual pornographic web pages is 372 million. The value of keeping kids safe from internet pornography: Priceless. A price too high, apparently, for the U.S. Supreme Court. The Court ruled 5-4 that the Child Online Protection Act (COPA) which requires commercial sex sites to verify every user's age, likely violates adults' free speech 'right' of unfettered access to online smut. The justices bounced COPA back to a lower court for a new trial, where legal analysts say it has almost no chance of survival... According to Filterview, 26 children's character names - from Barbie to Pokemon - were linked to thousands of porn sites (luring children into the world of porn). The average age at which children are exposed to online obscenity is eleven. And 80% of 15 to 17 year olds with internet access admit to multiple exposures to hardcore porn." -*World* 7/2004. Did the Founding Fathers intend freedom of speech should include such wickedness?

JOHN KERRY'S RELIGIOUS ADVISOR.

Mara Vanderslice has been added to the Kerry team. Wm. Donahue of the Catholic League said, "It is an incredible slap in the face to evangelical Christians to have a woman who is associated with Marxist politics, and [who in college] engaged in the most left-wing demonstrations in the country, trying to shut down Washington D.C." He also said, "Catholics will be interested to know she's also spoken for ACT UP." -*The Servant*, 7/2004. Ed. ACT UP is one of the most radical homosexual groups.
