WANTED: MEN OF GOD WORTHY OF THE NAME!

“Neither count I my life dear to myself...that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the Gospel of the grace of God.’ Acts 20:24. The Church at this moment needs men, the right kind of men, bold men. The talk is that we need revival, that we need a new baptism of the Spirit - and God knows we must have both; but God will not revive mice. He will not fill rabbits with the Holy Ghost. We languish for men who feel themselves expendable in the warfare of the soul, who cannot be frightened by threats of death for they have already died to the allurements of the world. Such men will be free from the compulsions that control and squeeze weaker men...These free men will serve God and mankind from motives too high to be understood by the rank and file of religious entertainers who shuttle in and out of the sanctuary. They will make no decisions out of fear, take no course out of a desire to please, accept no service for financial considerations, perform no religious act out of mere custom; nor will they allow themselves to be influenced by the desire for reputation. The true Church has never sounded out public expectations before launching her crusades. Her leaders heard from God, they knew the Lord's will and did it! Their people followed them - sometimes to triumph, oftener to insults and public persecution - and their sufficient reward was the satisfaction of being right in a wrong world!” - A.W.Tozer

Where are we going to find men of God like this? Most fundamental preachers are afraid of their own shadow! That's why they let immodest dress and sloppy, casual clothing that is not fit for attendance at Church, go unchallenged. To preach and warn against TV is a No, No! If you do it, you stand to lose some "good" Church members; or maybe your pastorate. More Baptist churches are run by a "Diotrephes" type Deacon (or a whole board of them) than you can number. Pastor after Pastor comes, stays two, three years only to leave rather than face these self-willed rulers; little wonder churches languish and die. There is a lot of talk about revival, but that's all it is. Few Christians want revival! Where are the believers who will be "**crucified with Christ.**"? *If they wanted revival, they'd give up the TV, spend time in prayer, go after souls with a passion, support the Pastor rather than run him down.* They'd desire Church services that promoted holiness and edification - not entertainment. We're not going to have revival with worldly Christians and weak-kneed preachers who will not take a stand on anything that will jeopardize their popularity or position. We have too many preachers who give the people what they want instead of what they need. God's people need some pretty strong measures today, and it will take some brave men to give it to them. These are the last days and the conditions described in II Tim.3 are widespread in the Church. We have a form of godliness, but where is the power of the Holy Spirit? Note: the HOLY Spirit! God says: "**Preach the Word; be instant in season, and out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears...**"

PRAISE GOD FOR THE THEE'S, THOU'S, ETC.

One common criticism of the KJV is the archaic words. How many times I have heard someone complain about the *thee's, thou's, ye*, etc. They are so hard to understand. Really? Many, including some professing Fundamentalists, will do anything to put down the KJV. Actually, the *thee's, thou's*, etc., help make the Word of God understandable. They were used by the translators because they represent what was very clear in the originals - is the word singular or plural? Personal pronouns in the original languages are quite distinct, but that is not so in modern English. In modern English "you" is both singular and plural. In the English of 1611 there was a distinction. In the KJV *thee, thou, thine, thy* are always singular; *you, your, ye* are always plural. The KJV is easier to understand than modern versions and it has no rival for accuracy - it is inerrant.

GOD ONLY WROTE ONE BIBLE

PEACE AT ALL COSTS.

This seems to be the case with Israel giving up the Gaza and parts of the West Bank to the Palestinians. Those places were settled years ago by Jews who paid a great price to occupy them and now they are being forcibly removed. Will it have the desired results? Most unlikely! MENTAL HEALTH SCREENING FOR ALL!

In 2002 President Bush established the New Freedom n Mental Health Commission. The goal is to screen the entire population (beginning with school children) for mental illness. According to *School Reform News* (6/05), Illinois has passed their own screening plan. The study group said they are no longer assuming children are mentally healthy - "with this program, *it will be presumed that all children need mental health services unless tests prove otherwise.*" One parent said, "We are moving toward social training over academic training. Since psychiatric involvement in education (has increased) SAT scores have gone down the past few decades. Evaluating mental conditions is not based on scientific evidence - it is subjective." (Emphasis mine). There is hardly a more dangerous profession in the land than the mental health people.

OMINOUS SUPREME COURT DECISIONS.

The recent decisions on displaying the Ten Commandments and on Eminent Domain have grave implications for all Americans and churches could be especially vulnerable - see below. *Legal Alert* (Aug. 2005) says, "CLA (Christian Law Ass'n) is already aware of one beach front church that was recently surprised to learn their current property is drawn as a shopping center on the city's future planning map. Our Founders recognized that governments were instituted among men to protect their God given rights...The highest court in our land has refused to recognize that God is Sovereign over the state in America. The Ten Commandments decisions are indicative of the fact that today's Supreme Court does not see God as either the Grantor or the Protector of our rights as Americans. The Eminent Domain case completes the circle by recognizing the state as the grantor and protector of our rights and freedoms." Ed. I assume most are aware of these cases. We have long had the instance of bigotry against religion - especially Bible religion. But who would have thought that one could have his property taken (paid for but there is no proof it will be equitable) simply because a government entity wants to obtain greater tax revenue.

GOOD CHURCH MEMBERS

It is said that Dr. Rowland Hill wanted to take his wife for a ride in the country. So, he went out to rent a horse and buggy. He said to the livery man: My wife deserves the very best. I want your best horse! As the man trotted out the horse, he said to Pastor Hill, "This horse is well-nigh perfect. He will obey every order you give him; he is willing, gentle, never balks, anticipates your every wish, and would die to please you." Dr. Hill listened intently and then said, "That's wonderful. Do you suppose that I could get him to join my Church? That is just the kind of members I am looking for." No doubt many a Pastor would say Amen to that! If you stop and think about the attributes concerning that horse, they would just about make a perfect Church member. How many are balky, easily offended, nasty if they don't have their own way, and if you try to correct them, they will surely bolt. Even in Bible believing churches it is common for **"Every man to do that which is right in his own eyes."** God says, **"And grieve not the Holy Spirit whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption. Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking be put away from you, with all malice; And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you."** Ephesians 4:30-32. If there is one thing a child of God ought to be, it is submissive. The Word says, **"...he is become the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him."** Hebrews 5:9.
