**ROMAN CATHOLIC CASUISTRY!**

**April 2007**

There are those who “envision a coming clash of civilizations which they are ever more ready to see as a confrontation between Islam and the West. But here in America, Muslims and Christians are factually in a position to show that the circumstances of democracy can just as well foster a dialogue among the believers in the One God,” Cardinal William Keeler of Baltimore said in Washington, Dec. 8, 1995, in an address to an inter-religious banquet in his honor sponsored by the American Muslim Council. The council gave Keeler its Mahmoud Abu Saud Excellence Award for 1995. In his acceptance, the cardinal urged Muslims and Catholics to work together to promote “a restoration of basic moral teaching in the public schools”; oppose all forms of pornography, “especially that directed at children”; and approach media leaders and advertisers “regarding immorality and violence in the media.” Noting that the interfaith banquet was held on the feast of the Immaculate Conception, Keeler said: “Catholics are delighted to learn that there are more verses in the Quran -- 34 of them -- which name the Blessed Virgin Mary than there are in the whole New Testament.” He said that while Muslims do not believe that Mary is the mother of God, they hold her in great esteem. Keeler said that though a “radical difference in faith forever separates us” with regard to Mary, “it paradoxically also holds us forever in conversation.” -*TBC Today* (11/6/06).

History has shown the Roman Catholic Church can co-exist with just about any group that will dialogue with her. They’ve been dialoguing for years with the Orthodox Church, the liberal World Council of Churches, the Southern Baptist Churches, Lutherans, the (New) Evangelicals, Mormons, Muslims, and I don’t know how many others. That diverse list shows you that they will sit down and dialogue with anyone. They feel that they have nothing to lose and everything to gain. They believe it is only a matter of time. The Catholic Church believes they are the true followers of God and that they will eventually overcome the others. After all, the “City of God” (Roman Catholicism a la Augustine) must finally overcome all others and rule the world. I remember the fabled story of the hunter and the bear. As the hunter was going through the woods, all of a sudden a bear came out from behind a tree. As the hunter raised his gun, the bear said. “Wait a minute. What is it you want?” Surprised, the hunter said, “I want a fur coat.” The bear said, “All I am looking for is a meal. Can’t we sit down and talk this over?” So, they sat down on a log. A few minutes later the bear walked away - alone. The bear had his meal and the hunter had his fur coat! After fifteen hundred years, few seem to realize that Rome does not basically change; she sometimes wears a different face or garb, but deep down, fundamentally, she does not change. Her goal is to rule the world. Those who understand and believe the Bible realize that she is the Harlot Church of Revelation 17 and will head up a worldwide apostate religion governed by Antichrist. Jesus said that His Church should separate not amalgamate! **“Come out from among them and be ye separate.” “Have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness but rather prove them.”** There are many such Scriptures.

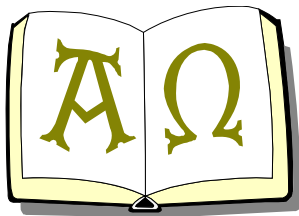

## NEWS YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT

**WAR PROTESTERS SPRAY PAINT U.S. CAPITOL.** During a rally in Washington protesting the war in Iraq, hundreds of anti-war protesters were allowed to desecrate government property by spray painting the capitol with anarchist symbols. I did not see or hear any report of this in any of the mainline media outlets. Capitol Police Chief Philip Morse ordered his officers to fall back and allow the protesters to exercise what he called “their first Amendment rights” to spray paint the Capitol steps with graffiti. He said, “The graffiti was easily removed by the staff. It is our duty and responsibility to protect the Capitol complex, while allowing the public to exercise their freedom of speech.” He even ordered officers not to arrest anyone! According to Family Research Council, public employees had to come in on their day off, at taxpayers’ expense to clean up the mess. -*AFA Action Alert* (1/31/07) Ed. Wow! Graffiti on government property is freedom of speech?

### **NORTH AMERICAN UNION MOVES FORWARD!**

The public-interest group Judicial Watch has released documents of a meeting last fall in Alberta, Canada called the “North American Forum, which was attended by former Defense Secretary, Donald Rumsfeld and other high-level U.S. Department of Defense officials. The NAF was sponsored by the Security and Prosperity Partnership of North America. (*Just like the devil’s crowd, a nice sounding name for an evil work*). Chris Farrell of Judicial Watch says, “They want to harmonize -- that’s their word --- rules, regulations between all three countries (U.S., Mexico, Canada) and to try to bring them all together and try to erase the boundaries and borders between the three countries.” The Conference was also attended by a number of high-level U.S. government and military officials. One of the more disturbing documents from the NAF meeting was the group director’s notes which contained the phrase “evolution by stealth,” in reference to policy debates, including debate on the North American countries’ integration and cooperation. -*Agape Press* (1/31/07). Ed. Many naive Americans think such a union cannot be. Others think it is good. By the time people wake up, it will be too late!

### **MAINE SCHOOL TEACHES TRANSGENDERING.**

Cony High School in Augusta, ME adjourned at 8:30 in the morning for a “Diversity Day,” which included a workshop called “Transgendering.” Mike Heath, of the Christian Civic League, said it included a presentation by a former student who is undergoing male hormone treatments and says she’s a boy. Heath says, “Maine invests almost a quarter of a million dollars a year in promoting homosexuality and ‘sexual orientation.’” He

stated that the state pushes this agenda by sponsoring Civil Rights Teams: “they are now going down to middle schools and elementary schools.” Those who opted out of the Diversity Day program were offered and alternative workshop on “hate crimes.” -*OneNewsNow* (2/5/07). Ed. What a choice? Those who promote homosexuality, etc. want all criticism of what they are doing to be labeled a “hate crime.” So, the young people will be taught to tolerate and “love” homosexuals, transgendered people, bisexuals, etc. Then, maybe next year, they will opt for the diversity workshop.

### **VACCINE MANDATED BY TEXAS GOVERNOR.**

Texas Gov. Rick Perry signed an executive order that requires all sixth grade girls to be vaccinated against the sexually transmitted HPV virus. The order does give parents the option of opting out. While healthcare officials are lauding the measure, Dr. Beverly Nuckois, a member of the Christian Medical Association says, “It’s not always been easy to do that (opt out) in the past.” -*OneNewsNow* (2/7/07). Ed. Even if you can opt out, the state has no right to prescribe medical treatment.

### **ILLEGAL ALIENS KILL MORE THAN IRAQ!**

Illegal aliens kill more Americans than the Iraq war according to a Family Security Matters report. They estimate 2,158 murders are committed every year by illegal aliens. Mike Cutler, former special agent with the U.S. Immigration Service said, “If our military understands that Iraq’s security depends... on the ability to protect its border against insurgents and terrorists, why is not our country protecting our own borders? If our borders are wide open, drugs, criminals, and terrorists are entering our country just as easily as the dishwashers.” -*OneNewsNow* (02/22/07)

### **CATHOLIC CLERGY PROMOTES AMNESTY!**

Senator Ted Kennedy has been traveling the country promoting his soon-to-be bill giving amnesty to illegal aliens. Joining Kennedy is Archbishop of Los Angeles, Cardinal Roger Mahoney. John Vinson, editor of Americans for Immigration Control contends it is against the law for a tax-exempt organization to lobby for amnesty. Vinson also said concerning the Cardinal: “I don’t give him high marks for moral authority because he has covered up priest pedophilia and has been reluctant to compensate victims of sexual abuse by Catholic clergy.” -*OneNewsNow* (3/9/07). Ed. Such lobbying is illegal, but that matters not to the Roman Catholic hierarchy. Anything that will benefit the Catholic Church is permissible. One big benefit is that practically all the illegal aliens from Mexico and South America are Roman Catholic.

## FIND YOUR PLACE AND FILL IT

The Bible says, **“Let us not be desirous of vain glory.”** ~Galatians 5:26. I remember reading of an incident that happened during the Civil War. A certain man wired President Lincoln saying that he was volunteering to serve as a General in the Union Army. Mr. Lincoln wired him back saying that they already had plenty of generals, but they did need a lot of good privates. The Bible also exhorts: **“For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think...”** ~Romans 12:3. The Church needs leaders, but it needs a lot more followers, foot-soldiers. Please note that it is God who gives the gifts; we do not select for ourselves where or how we are to serve. I believe it is quite evident that every member has at least one gift. Will the Lord reward someone for performing some service that was not God’s will? Let us all find the place God has for us and then do our best to fulfill it faithfully. If you are saved and have not been baptized and/or are not a member of a local Fundamental (Baptist) Church, you are out of the will of God!
