**FALSE DOCTRINE OF PRAGMATISM.**

**March 2008**

The late Paris Reidhead was a missionary in Africa for some years and continued his ministry in the States pastoring and preaching. Though he was in the Evangelical camp, like Tozer, he was a cut above the great majority of them. The following excerpt comes from his sermon "Ten Shekels and a Shirt" (from Judges 17 & 18) and sounds as fresh and pertinent today as when it was preached back in the mid 1960s.

Would I be out of line if I were to talk to you for a little while about utilitarian religion and expedient Christianity? And a youthful God? I would like to call attention to the fact that our day is a day which the ruling philosophy is pragmatism. You understand what I mean by pragmatism, pragmatism means if it works it's true. If it succeeds it's good. And the test of all practices, all principles, all truth, so called, all teaching, is do they work? Now, according to pragmatism, the greatest failures of the ages have been some of the men God honored most.

For instance, whereas Noah was a mighty good ship builder, his main occupation wasn't ship building, it was preaching. He was a terrible failure as a preacher. His wife and three children and their wives are all he had. Seven converts in 120 years, you wouldn't call that particularly effective. And then we come down across the years to another man by the name of Jeremiah. He was a mighty effective preacher, but ineffective as far as results were concerned. If you were to measure statistically how successful Jeremiah was, he would probably get a large cipher. For we find that he lost out with the people, he lost out with royalty, even the ministerial association voted against him and wouldn't have anything to do with him. He had everything fail. The only one he seemed able to please was.... God, but otherwise he was a distinct failure. And then we come to another well known person, the Lord Jesus Christ, who was a failure from judging all the standards. He never succeeded in organizing a church or denomination. He wasn't able to build a school. He didn't succeed in getting a mission board established. He never had a book printed.

The question comes then to this, "what is the standard of success and by what are we going to judge our lives and our ministry?" And the question that you are going to ask yourself, "Is God an end or is He a means?" Our generation is prepared to honor successful choices. As long as a person can get things done or get the job done then our generation is prepared to say well done. And so we've got to ask ourselves at the very outset of our ministry, and our pilgrimage, and our walk, "Are we going to be Levites who serve God for ten shekels and a shirt?" (Judges 17:7-11), serve men, perhaps in the name of God, rather than God. For though he was a Levite and performed religious activities, he was looking for a place, which would give him recognition, a place which would give him acceptance, a place which would give him security, a place where he could shine in terms of those values which were important to him. His whole business was serving in religious activities, so it had to be a religious job. He was very happy when he found that Micah had an opening. But he had decided that he was worth ten shekels and a shirt, and he was prepared to sell himself to anyone that would give that much. (page 2)

## NEWS YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT

### **PSYCHIATRISTS NEED A PSYCHIATRIST.**

Disorders plague court psychiatrists, judge concludes: 'Name-calling' racks 'dysfunctional' office! Name calling, factions and conspiracies are common in the "dysfunctional" office of more than a dozen psychiatrists who analyze criminals for the courts, an Edmonton judge has found. In a 55-page decision released Friday, Court of Queen's Bench Justice Erik Lefsrud ruled that allegations of defamation in the department were unfounded, but the department was plagued by infighting and lack of leadership. "What emerged is a picture of a very dysfunctional working environment in which name calling, finger-pointing, intransigence and conspiratorial workings have thwarted the best intentions of all the psychiatrists involved," he wrote. "How such a group of obviously intelligent professionals could work themselves into such a state is beyond comprehension." In testimony and letters doctors told of "politics of intimidation," "gossip and innuendo," as well as "personal attacks" and power struggles. *TBC* (11/7/07). Ed. ### **FAMOUS ATHEIST BELIEVES IN A CREATOR.**

Following is from "Former Atheist Darwinian Philosopher Explains His 'Conversion,'" Lifesite.net, 11/2/07: "Former Darwinian atheist philosopher Antony Flew has published a new book, 'There Is a God: How the World's Most Notorious Atheist Changed His Mind,' to explain his move from being one of the world's leading exponents of the pure materialist Darwinian philosophy to belief in the existence of a personal deity who created the universe. Flew, an Oxford educated philosopher described by some as 'legendary,' first announced his discovery of 'a god' in 2004. Flew had been one of the 20th century's leading proponents of the pure atheistic Darwinian doctrines that categorically reject any possibility of a creative divine being. His ideas paved the way for thinkers such as Richard Dawkins, the UK's most virulent opponent of religious belief. 'It was empirical evidence,' he told an interviewer, 'the evidence uncovered by the sciences. But it was a philosophical inference drawn from the evidence.' Flew told Dr. Benjamin Wiker that two factors in 'were decisive.' 'One was my growing empathy with the insight of Einstein and other noted scientists that there had to be an Intelligence behind the integrated complexity of the physical Universe. The second was my own insight that the integrated complexity of life itself -- which is far more complex than the physical Universe -- can only be explained in terms of an Intelligent Source.' He told Wiker, 'I believe the origin of life and reproduction

simply cannot be explained from a biological standpoint despite numerous efforts to do so. With every passing year, the more that was discovered about the richness and inherent intelligence of life, the less it seemed likely that a chemical soup could magically generate the genetic code.' Emphasizing he remains a Deist, not a Christian, he told Wiker he does not 'accept any claim of divine revelation' but is continuing to study them, particularly those of Christianity."-*FBIS* (11/9/07). Ed. One wonders if a few other scientists will wake up.

**EXPERT DEBUNKS GLOBAL WARMING!** A prominent meteorologist with more than 54 years of experience is calling global warming an "outrageous scam" and a "manufactured crisis." John Coleman has been a television meteorologist since 1953. His credentials include being the first weather forecaster for the television show Good Morning America and founder of The Weather Channel. About six or seven years ago Coleman says he began to hear about "global warming" and decided to dig deeper into the subject. He said, "I am not talking about reading media accounts but getting down to basic research papers...It became very clear that it was a manufactured crisis." He said the science that favors global warming "has been manipulated and much of the data has been manufactured." His blog states that natural cycles in weather are more responsible for any climate change. -*One News Now*. (11/14/07)
