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COURAGEOUS OR CORRUPTED?

September 2010

[TBC (6/3/10): The most recent graduation ceremony at Liberty University (founded by Jerry Falwell) saw the commencement address given by Mormon Glenn Beck. The following comments were published on the Liberty University website.] Beck said it was courageous for Liberty to invite him and that being here was not an endorsement of his Mormon faith. He said accepting the invite to speak is “an endorsement of your faith. This is a time when we all need to come together. We may have differences, but we need to find those things that unite us. “Beck told the graduates that they must have faith and courage to overcome challenges that face the world today, such as high unemployment and the weak dollar. “Turn to God and live,” he said. “Life is only what you make of it. Nothing more, nothing less. ... God is the truth. The truth will consume everything that is not true. ... The world is full of lies.” Beck urged graduates not to underestimate the power of the atonement. When he was 13, his mother took her life. He said he nearly followed in her footsteps. “As a man who needed the atonement ... I read the promise. He will carry your burdens. I made Him a promise. You keep your word and I will keep mine,” he said. “He will never break his promise, and now it’s all up to me. [The atonement] is the most powerful thing you will ever encounter.”

[TBC: “It is impossible to find common ground with someone who promotes “another Jesus” (2 Corinthians 11:4). Mormonism has never repudiated their teaching that Jesus and Lucifer are “spirit brothers.” Jess L. Christensen, Institute of Religion director at Utah State University, Logan, Utah writes, “On first hearing, the doctrine that Lucifer and our Lord, Jesus Christ, are brothers may seem surprising to some-especially to those unacquainted with latter-day revelations. But both the scriptures and the prophets affirm that Jesus Christ and Lucifer are indeed offspring of our Heavenly Father and, therefore, spirit brothers” (Originally published in the LDS publication Ensign: “I Have a Question,” Ensign, Jun 1986, 24-27). Christensen is simply echoing the discourse delivered on October 30, 1870 by Mormon President Brigham Young in the new tabernacle at Salt Lake City, Utah: ““Who will redeem the earth, who will go forth and make the sacrifice for the earth and all things it contains?” The eldest son said: ‘Here am I; but he did not say ‘send me.’ But the second one, which was ‘Lucifer, son of the morning,’ said, ‘Lord, here am I, send me, I will redeem every son and daughter of Adam and Eve that lives on the earth,...’ “]

Ed. There is no common ground with Mormons (or other cults). It is not Christian in any sense. Joseph Smith said that “In the beginning, the Head of the Gods, called a council of the Gods.” The Bible, God’s Holy Word says there is only ONE GOD – Isaiah 44:4; 46:9; I Timothy 2:4; etc. Smith also said, “The Father has a body of flesh and bones as tangible as man’s.” Some of the other gross heresies: Jesus Christ was not begotten by the Holy Ghost but by Adam; Jesus was a polygamist (some of His wives –Mary, Martha, and Mary Magadeline); By going through the Mormon ritual, men can become gods; If you think all of this resembles Christianity, you must not have ever read the Bible! In fact, former Mormon President Gordon B. Hinckley actually said Christianity of the Bible and Mormonism are not the same religion. Speaking in Switzerland on June 6, 1999, he said: “The traditional Christ of whom they speak is not the Christ of whom I speak.” Amen, how true! Listen to what God says: **“But though we or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed.”** ~Galatians 1:8 (v. 9 repeats it). Yet when these deceitful Mormon missionaries come to your door, they try to get you to believe they believe the Bible and they are Bible believing Christians.



NEWS YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT

RENOWNED ATHEIST CHANGED HIS VIEW.

Professor Antony Flew, the rationalist philosopher who died on April 8 aged 87, spent much of his life denying the existence of God until, in 2004, he dramatically changed his mind. Flew always described himself as a “negative atheist”, asserting that “theological propositions can neither be verified nor falsified by experience,” a position he expounded in his classic paper, *Theology and Falsification* (1950), reputedly the most frequently-quoted philosophical publication of the second half of the 20th century. He argued that any philosophical debate about the Almighty must begin by presuming atheism, placing the burden of proof on those who believe that God exists. “We reject all transcendent supernatural systems, not because we’ve examined or could have examined each in turn, but because it does not seem to us that there is any good evidence in reason to postulate anything behind or beyond this natural universe,” he proclaimed... When Flew revealed that he had come to the conclusion that there might be a God after all, it came as a shock to his fellow atheists, who had long regarded him as one of their foremost champions... After months of soul-searching, Flew concluded that research into DNA had “shown, by the almost unbelievable complexity of the arrangements which are needed to produce life, that intelligence must have been involved”. Moreover, though he accepted Darwinian evolution, he felt that it could not explain the beginnings of life. “I have been persuaded that it is simply out of the question that the first living matter evolved out of dead matter and then developed into an extraordinarily complicated creature,” he said. Flew went on to make a video of his conversion entitled *Has Science Discovered God?* and seemed to want to atone for past errors: “As people have certainly been influenced by me, I want to try and correct the enormous damage I may have done,” he said. -TBC (5/12/10). Ed. Sad to say, as far as we know, his “conversion” was not a Biblical one, but a change from atheism to a belief that there is a God. While there are many flaws in the theory of evolution, we have often and for many years said, that there are three fundamental things evolution cannot explain. It cannot explain THE ORIGIN OF MATTER – THE ORIGIN OF LIFE - THE ORIGIN OF EVIL! The Bible clearly explains all three and in fact, is the only reasonable explanation. We have also said many years ago that evolution is primarily a way to explain away the reality of God. But He cannot be explained away, for there is no other explanation. SOME GOOD NEWS FOR A CHANGE! Wisconsin

High Court Upholds Gay Marriage Ban. The Christian Post reports that the Wisconsin Supreme Court has upheld the state’s ban on same-sex civil unions. The court unanimously affirmed that the state’s traditional “marriage amendment was adopted by the people of Wisconsin using the process prescribed by the constitution, and is properly now part of our constitution.” The state approved the amendment with 59 percent of the vote in 2006, but the amendment was challenged the following year. The amendment reads, “Only a marriage between one man and one woman shall be valid or recognized as a marriage in this state. A legal status identical or substantially similar to that of marriage for unmarried individuals shall not be valid or recognized in this state.” Traditional marriage supporters cheered the decisions. “Marriage and the will of the people are the clear winners in this decision,” said Julianne Appling, president of Wisconsin Family Council.” Ed. It is good to hear of some sanity (and moral persuasion) in this issue. However, you can be sure that this will be appealed to the U.S. Supreme Court.

THOUSANDS OF SOLDIERS UNFIT FOR DUTY!

More than 13,000 active-duty Army soldiers – the equivalent of four combat brigades – are sidelined as unfit for war because of injury, illness or mental stress... The non-deployable soldiers make up roughly 10 percent of the active duty soldiers currently in Iraq and Afghanistan. Thousands more Army reservists and National Guard soldiers are considered unfit to deploy. Brig. General Gary Check says it is not going to go away...If anything it is going to get larger... Some are unfit due to combat wounds but far more numerous are soldiers with non-combat conditions including coronary disease, schizophrenia and bipolar disorder, acute anxiety... Sometimes these cases are complicated by drug or alcohol abuse... -AOL News 7/7/10. Ed. As I read the article, it seems to me that the majority of cases reflect mental illnesses. 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AN UNEXPECTED LESSON
