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THE PLACE OF POWER!

Spurgeon said many years ago, "Most Christian work is done with the same power with which Christians served the devil." Of course, that is "flesh power" which can mimic but not perform the work of God. Of course, you have got to be in the place of God's appointment to do His will and work. Vance Havner said, "Are you where God wants you, 'perfect and complete in all the will of God?'" God told Elijah to go to Cherith and hide by the brook and added, 'I have commanded the ravens to feed thee THERE.'" Later God told Elijah to go to Zarephath and 'dwell THERE,' and added, 'I have commanded a widow woman THERE to sustain thee.' Mind you, He did not promise to feed Elijah just anywhere. He did not say, 'Just ramble over the countryside anywhere you like and I will feed you.' It was limited to THERE, the place of God's will. God only provides where He guides. The place of His purpose is the place of His power and His provision. But we must be THERE!" There are no doubt many of God's children who are not in the place of God's appointment but in the place of their own choosing. Of course, many of them attend church regularly and enter into some Christian work, but is it anything that will count for eternity? How can one really serve God if he is not in the place which God has marked out for him? As I mentioned, the flesh can perform "Christian" deeds but what do they amount to? It is still true, even as Jesus has said, "**The flesh profiteth nothing.**" Apart from being saved, what is more important than being in the place which God has prepared for you.

I thought of some of the great servants of God and what happened to them when they were not THERE, that is they were out of God's will; not in the place or circumstances of God's choosing. For example, David was not THERE (not in the place he should have been) when he fell into the sin with Bathsheba. In II Samuel 11:1 it says, "And it came to pass after the year was expired, at the time when kings go forth to battle, that David sent Joab, and his servants with him...But David tarried still at Jerusalem..." You know the rest of the story and you know the dire consequences. Clearly, David was not THERE! And he paid a terrible price for being in the wrong place! What about God's great servant Abraham. God had promised that he and Sarah would have a child together. But they both became impatient and tried to help God out by using Hagar. However, God did not recognize Ishmael and he was nothing but trouble. And his descendants are still with us and they are nothing but trouble. As far as being in the will of God concerning this matter, Abraham was not THERE! Another servant of God, Jehoshaphat, basically a good man, also made a decision that put him in the wrong place. He "joined affinity" with wicked king Ahab. And Jehu the prophet was sent to him with a dire message: "...therefore is wrath upon thee from before the Lord." Because of space limitations, we'll mention just one more: Peter. When Jesus was on trial it says that Peter "followed afar off" He was in the wrong place; he wasn't THERE! The only safe way is to keep close to the Lord, stay in the will of God – THERE! Here are a couple of verses of Scripture it would do well to keep in mind: "**Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh read corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.**" ~Galatians 6:7,8.

NEWS YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT

EVANGELICALS AND CATHOLICS TOGETHER FOR CHRISTIAN ROCK.

The 13th annual Lifest Christian rock festival in Oshkosh, Wisconsin, featured five days of rock & roll, complete with a Catholic mass and a message by well-known evangelical speaker Greg Laurie. Some 20,000 people gathered July 6-10 to hear Christian rock groups such as Hawk Nelson, Skillet, TobyMac, Lincoln Brewster, MercyMe, Superchick, Newsboys, and Kutless. Greg Laurie of International Harvest Crusades, spoke on the last day of the event, preceded by a Catholic mass led by bishop David Ricken of the Diocese of Green Bay. Lifest founder Bob Lenz said, "We want to get all the flavors of the church" ("Green Bay Bishop David Ricken Leads Mass," Green Bay Press Gazette, July 10, 2011). –FBIS (7/22/11). Ed. STUDY SHOWS ABORTION TIED TO DEPRESSION,

SUICIDE. Women who have undergone an abortion have an 81 percent higher risk for mental health problems and are more likely to attempt suicide, abuse alcohol and suffer depression, [Baptist Press](#) reports. The study appears in the latest edition of the *British Journal of Psychiatry* and is getting considerable attention from both sides of the abortion debate. The researchers examined 22 studies from 1995-2009 involving 877,000 women, including 163,000 who had experienced an abortion. The paper's author, Priscilla K. Coleman of Bowling Green State University, said there actually are "hundreds of studies" showing a link between abortion and serious mental health risks, and that three recent studies that reached a very different conclusion had major flaws. "[T]here are in fact some real risks associated with abortion that should be shared with women as they are counseled prior to an abortion decision," Coleman writes, chiding the research community for not conducting unbiased research. The fact that the study was published in one of the world's leading psychiatric journals is important, those who monitor the abortion debate say. –*Religion Today* (9/5/11). Ed. I have read similar studies over the years, but they are not likely to change many people's minds. The whole abortion business is built on satisfying self and money.

ELIMINATING THOSE WITH GENETIC DISEASES

New pre-natal screening test makes eliminating all people with genetic disease an achievable reality. [Excerpts] 'Fetal DNA tests: Are we finally entering an era of eugenics?' As an Ashkenazi Jew planning to have a baby, Fliesler sought prenatal screening for Tay-Sachs disease, an incurable and lethal condition. But she asks, 'What about diseases that don't severely limit lifespan and aren't that disabling?' What should we screen for? Down's syndrome? Genes associated with bowel or breast cancer? X chromosomes? Where do we draw the line? Now, however, there is a new non-invasive test that is highly accurate for screening babies early in the first third of pregnancy. This test may mean that every pregnant woman will in the future be tested at an early stage in pregnancy and offered an abortion if their baby carries any genes (including a female chromosome) that they find undesirable. The Human Genetics Commission (HGC) [United Kingdom], a government advisory committee, has already given the green light to preconception genetic tests saying that there are no specific 'social, ethical or legal' reasons that stand in the way. The UK National Screening Committee will now consider this advice as it decides whether widespread screening should be introduced in GP surgeries, family planning centres, IVF clinics or pharmacies. Our society's increasing obsession with celebrity status, physical perfection and high intelligence fuels the view that the lives of people with disabilities or genetic diseases are somehow less worth living... –*TBC* (9/8/11). AMERICANS TAILOR RELIGION TO FIT OWN IDEAS.

New research reveals America's drift from clearly defined religious denominations to faiths cut to fit personal preferences, according to a report by [USA Today](#). Religion statistics expert George Barna's new book on U.S. Christians, *Futurecast*, tracks changes from 1991 to 2011 in annual national surveys and shows that all the major trend lines of religious belief and behavior ran downward except two: More people claim they have accepted Jesus as their savior and expect to go to heaven, and more say they haven't been to church in the past six months... In 1991, 24% were "unchurched." Today, it's 37%.. When he measures people by their belief in seven essential doctrines, defined by the National Association of Evangelicals' Statement of Faith, only 7% of those surveyed qualified. Barna: "People say: 'I believe in God. I believe the Bible is a good book. Then, I believe whatever I want.'" –*Religion Today* (9/14/11). Ed. Repent and give up the junk food and start to "eat" healthy. Feed on the Word and pray. Get involved in eternal things. God says to you, **"Love not the world, neither the thing *that are* in the world...For all that *is* in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but of the world. And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof..."** ~1 John 2:15-17
