



DEFENDING THE FAITH!

In a day when the Word of God is being compromised by professed believers in true inspiration, C.H. Spurgeon wrote: “We must defend the faith! What would have happened to us if our fathers had not maintained it? If Confessors, Martyrs, and Covenantors had been recant to the faith and the name of Jesus where would have been the churches today? Must we not play the man...It is very pretty, is it not, to read of Luther and his brave deeds? Everybody admires Luther. Yes, yes, but you do not want anyone else to do the same today. When you go to the Zoological Gardens you all admire the bear but you don’t want a bear at home nor wandering the streets, you tell me that would be unbearable...So, we admire a man who is firm in the faith, say 400 years ago are sort of a bear pit or iron cage for him but such a man today is a nuisance and must be put down. Call him a narrow-minded bigot or give him a worse name if you can think of one. Yet imagine in those ages past, Luther, Zwingli, Calvin and their compeers said, ‘The world is out of order but if we try to set it right, we shall only make a great row and get ourselves into disgrace. Let us go to our chamber, put on our bedcaps and sleep over these times and perhaps when we awake things would have grown better.’ Such conduct by them would have entailed upon us a heritage of error. Age after age would have gone down into the infernal deeps and pestiferous bogs of error and would have swallowed all. These men loved the faith and name of Jesus too well to see them trampled on. Note what we owe them and pay to our sons the debt we owe to our fathers. It is today as in the Reformers day. Decision is needed.”

We have many Fundamental Baptists who apparently don’t think anything worth fighting for. I was told the following by a man who was present at a Fundamental Baptist preachers meeting, It is amazing that more than one speaker said that there were four things not worth fighting for; they are the underlined here for you: We need to preach the Gospel but we also need to “earnestly contend for the faith.” One of the reasons for the compromise, mixture, declension and confusion among Fundamental Baptists is the failure of many preachers (who may be sound in doctrine) to point out compromise among the people of God. Worldly sensual dress may not be as important as Bible versions, but it is certainly is wrong and I believe it says a lot about the low level of spirituality. Separation, fellowship with unbelievers, which is clearly a sin. That means you may have a New Evangelical (or even liberal) in your pulpit, etc. Whatever happened to **“come out from among them and be ye separate.”**? Then, it is amazing that so called Bible believers are not concerned about whether they are using the true Word of God or not. If that is not worth fighting for what is? All modern versions teach error and deviate from the King James Bible. They teach error eliminating hundreds of verses and destroying others with marginal notes. If that is not worth fighting for, nothing is! Imagine – Fundamental Bible believers with a phony Bible. We are admonished, we are commanded (this is not just good advice) to **“earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints.”** It was once delivered! Where is it? It can’t be in a modern version; they are all different and contain errors. God didn’t give a Bible with error in it! Let us be able to say with the Apostle Paul: **“I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith.”** ~II Timothy 4:7. The Apostle contended for these things and a whole lot more!

NEWS YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT

SUPREME COURT AND HOMOSEXUAL MARRIAGE!

The nation's highest court declined to review petitions from lower courts whose jurisdiction covers nearly a dozen states. The decision upheld court decisions striking down bans on same-sex unions in those states. The decision was announced quietly, but the resulting shockwaves will be felt across the nation. The court validated three federal appeals covering Colorado, Indiana, Kansas, North Carolina, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Utah, Virginia, West Virginia, Wisconsin and Wyoming, according to Bloomberg. By declining to hear the petitions brought forth from the jurisdictions, the Supreme Court left intact appeals courts decisions to strike down same-sex marriage bans in the locales. Couples in those states should soon be able to obtain marriage licenses and be legally wed. The announcement led a large group of same-sex marriage supporters gathered outside the court to celebrate. They cheered, waved flags, hugged each other and embraced the landmark decision. -AOL News Ed. We said it long ago and many times, it is going to be the rule in all states. God help America.

POPE SAYS "WE ARE ON THE WAY TO RECONCILIATION AND COMMUNION"

- Pope Francis told a massive crowd at St. Peter's Square that it is the devil who causes disunity among Christians but that "we are on the way to reconciliation and communion." On October 8, the pope said, "the Church is tempted by the devil who tries to divide it ... [and] she has been marred by serious and painful divisions" ("Pope Francis: The Devil Works to Divide Christians," Breitbart.com, Oct. 8, 2014). He claims that "behind all these divisions there is always pride and selfishness." He called for a "spiritual ecumenism" that ignores doctrinal differences and focuses "not on what divides us, but rather on what unites us." He concluded by saying, "History has separated us, but we are on the way to reconciliation and communion! And this is true!" The pope is right in this matter. The Bible prophesies an end-time, one-world "church," and Rome is doubtless at the heart and soul of it. -FBIS (10/24/14)

CITY THREATENS MINISTERS WHO WILL NOT MARRY GAYS.

The city of Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, is threatening two ordained Christian ministers with arrest if they refuse to perform wedding ceremonies for same-sex couples. The Hitching Post Wedding Chapel is across the street from the Kootenai County Clerk's office, which issues marriage licenses.

Last week, Donald Knapp and his wife Evelyn, both ordained ministers who run the chapel, respectfully declined to perform a same-sex "marriage" ceremony. According to the Coeur d'Alene city attorney, they now face up to 180 days in jail and up to \$1,000 in fines for each day they decline to perform that ceremony. City officials said the Knapps are required to perform such ceremonies or face months in jail and/or thousands of dollars in fines. The city claims its "non-discrimination" ordinance requires them to perform same-sex wedding ceremonies despite the fact that they are Christians and the chapel publicly states it only performs Christian-based ceremonies. The Knapps have secured legal counsel through Alliance Defending Freedom and have filed a lawsuit claiming the city's ordinance prohibiting discrimination against gays and lesbians is unconstitutionally forcing them to violate their religious beliefs by performing same-sex marriages. How many once vibrant Christians we have seen lose their spirituality and usefulness by neglecting God’s means of bearing fruit? You need to read your Bible and pray seriously every day.
