



ANOTHER MESSAGE ON REVIVAL!

You have no doubt heard and read many sermons on revival. There has been a lot of talk and prayers for revival the past few years, but we just don't see it! What is wrong? Why don't we have revival with all this attention being given to it? Because sermons on revival (though good and proper) do not produce revival. The proper response to a sermon on revival may produce the desired effect, but not the sermon per se. There will be no revival (in the local Church or anywhere else) until God's people repent of their sins and fully obey His Word. There is no magic formula for revival or anything else! I believe the plain truth is God's people do not really want revival! Any individual Christian can have it, if he wants it; if he will pay the price. God tells us what is needed: **"Behold, the LORD's hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that he will not hear: But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear."** ~Isaiah 59:1,2. You can preach and pray all you want to, but unless there is honest, heartfelt repentance and forsaking of known sins, there will be no answer. The problem is, we are carnal, worldly, self willed, gossipy, deceitful, prayerless, ease loving, self satisfied, etc., but we are not about to acknowledge it or change. There will be no revival without *absolute* obedience to God and His Word! *Prayer is no substitute for obedience!* God says, **"If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear me."** ~Psalm 66:18.

I don't see how one can have revival without being filled with the Holy Spirit. Anyone with a little discernment can see that Christians who are filled with the Spirit are few and far between, if you can find one! Is a Spirit filled Christian going to look at TV? Will he gossip? Will he absent himself from Church for some worldly pleasure or some personal end? Will he be easily offended? Will he insist on having his own way? Tozer said words to the effect he did not think there were very many Christians who wanted to be Spirit filled - to be controlled absolutely by God. He also said, *"Our mistake is that we want God to send revival on our terms... We are calling on God to send fire on our altars ignoring the fact that they are our altars and not God's."* I agree! You can have revival if you want it; if you pay the price, humble yourself and truly confess and forsake your sins. We talk about revival but we don't really want it! I have said it literally hundreds of times: There are no short-cuts to spirituality! One of the greatest problems in our Fundamental Baptist churches is the people have a head-knowledge of much Bible truth, but it has not gripped and changed them. Vance Havner said, *"The times are desperate but the saints are not!"* Someone asked Gypsy Smith, "How can we have revival?" The wise old preacher replied, "Take a piece of chalk and draw a circle on the floor. Then, step inside the circle and pray: 'Lord, send a revival inside this circle.' Don't get out until He sends it!" It was times much as we face today, days of apostasy and defeat when Habakkuk prayed: **"O LORD, revive thy work in the midst of the years..."** Child of God, do you really want revival? Why not get alone with God right now and pursue it on His terms? **"If my people, which are called by My name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from Heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land."** ~II Chronicles 7:14

PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH ORDAINS LESBIAN COUPLE.

Days after America's largest Presbyterian denomination approved an amendment to its constitution changing its definition of marriage to include same-sex couples, a lesbian couple will be ordained as ministers Sunday at First & Central Presbyterian Church in Wilmington, Delaware. Kaci Clark-Porter and Holly, who married three years ago, will be the first-ever same-sex couple to be jointly ordained, according to USA Today, which says the denomination couldn't point to other examples. Last year, Presbyterian Church (USA) approved a vote on an amendment to change their official definition of marriage from "a man and a woman" to "two people, traditionally a man and a woman." And on Tuesday, the proposed change to PCUSA's Book of Order got the necessary number of presbytery votes. The ordination service will be held Sunday afternoon... -*Christian Post* (3/24/15)

PRESBYTERIAN MINISTER DENIES EXISTENCE OF GOD.

Presbyterian minister declares that he doesn't believe in God, who he says is a figment of one's imagination. John Shuck — who many question why he's a minister in the first place — says God isn't supernatural. "God is a human product as opposed to special revelation from a divine being," the PC (USA) minister wrote on an atheist blog called "The Friendly Atheist's Blog." The headline of his post reads, "I'm a Presbyterian Minister Who Doesn't Believe in God," where he calls himself a "proud minister" of the church. Even though Shuck says he doesn't appreciate "being told I'm not truly a Christian," his heretical statements make such a statement ironic in the eyes of most denominational and non-denominational churches alike. "God is a symbol of myth-making and not credible as a supernatural being or force," Shuck alleges. "Jesus may have been an historical figure, but most of what we know about him is in the form of legend."

Rewriting the Good Book

According to Shuck's statements, he has rewritten the book on Christianity, insisting that belief in Jesus Christ as one's savior and asking God's forgiveness for one's sins are mere technicalities that can be overlooked or worked past. "I believe one of the newer religious paths could be a 'belief-less' Christianity," Shuck expressed. "In this 'sect,' one is not required to believe things." The atheist "minister" declares that in his sect of Christianity, societal mores and conventions trump God's written Word in the Bible — and that heaven and hell are mere figments of one's imagination. "One learns and draws upon practices and products of our cultural tradition to create meaning in the present," Shuck explains, clarifying his new philosophical worldview. "Human consciousness is the result of natural selection, so there's no afterlife." After establishing the tenets of his new atheistic beliefs, Shuck goes on to attack traditional Bible-believing Christians, implying that born-again believers have it all wrong and are antiquated in their belief system. He says Christians on the Left, who discount the Bible and buy into the latest cultural conventions, have graduated to some kind of a higher understanding of the world. *News With Views* (4/24/15) Ed.
