Perhaps we have made some progress in the Christian life, but we have settled upon the notion that we are all that we need to be, and that we are doing all that can be done. There is no stretching out for more or better things. The widow of the great artist Opie said of him: "I never saw him satisfied with one of his productions, and often, very often, have I seen him enter my sitting-room, and throwing himself in an agony of despondence on the sofa, exclaim, 'I never, never shall be a painter as long as I live!'" Now, that was a noble form of despair which is totally unknown to the *average* would-be painters or artists. Beloved Christian, I challenge you to ask God to help you come to grips with that kind of attitude and dedication to the Lord Jesus Christ and His work! And never waver from it until you are perfectly holy (which of course you never will be in this life) and you have accomplished all that He has for you to do. There is always more ground to be possessed even as Joshua challenged the Israelites of his day.

One curse of the Church is that many believers are content to be *average* and not a few do not mind being a little below *average*. You attend church a little, give a little, witness a little (maybe), pray a little and so on. God is looking for, and the lateness of the hour demands, that every Christian be completely sold out to God. *Average* Christians never did get the job done and they never will! Over and over again we read in God's Word that He expects us to be sold out, totally committed, completely surrendered to Christ. The Apostle Paul was no *average* Christian. Listen to the words he penned under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit: **"Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before, I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus."** ~*Philippians 3:13,14*. That doesn't sound like *average*. That doesn't sound like very many Christians in our day. Too many are living in the past, remembering their former days of spiritual growth or victory; but they have had little or nothing for some time now. Not many are reaching forth...straining to accomplish more in the name of and for Jesus Christ. Never have so many lived for ease and pleasure as the present generation in America. And many Christians have caught this deadly virus. There is a good deal of talk about revival, but where do we see people who are willing to pay the price of revival. Where are those who will empty themselves of SELF that they might be filled with the Holy Spirit? How many Christians do you know of whom you can say, "I believe he is filled with the Holy Spirit?" Child of God, Jesus is calling and He is saying, **"Take up your cross and follow Me."** Will you take up the challenge; obey His command? Will you give up SELF; surrender to Jesus who went to Calvary for you? Will you say, **"Here am I Lord, send me"?**

NEWS YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT

VATICAN RECOGNIZES STATE OF PALESTINE.

The Vatican officially recognized the state of Palestine in a new treaty finalized Wednesday, immediately sparking Israeli ire and accusations that the move hurt peace prospects. The treaty, which concerns the activities of the Catholic Church in Palestinian territory, makes clear that the Holy See has switched its diplomatic recognition from the Palestine Liberation Organization to the state of Palestine. The Vatican had welcomed the decision by the U.N. General Assembly in 2012 to recognize a Palestinian state. But the treaty is the first legal document negotiated between the Holy See and the Palestinian state and constitutes official diplomatic recognition. “Yes, it’s a recognition that the state exists,” said the Vatican spokesman, the Rev. Federico Lombardi. The Israeli foreign ministry said it was “disappointed” by the development. “This move does not promote the peace process and distances the Palestinian leadership from returning to direct and bilateral negotiations,” the ministry said in a text message. “Israel will study the agreement and will consider its steps accordingly.” The treaty was finalized days before Palestinian President Mahmoud Abbas visits Pope Francis at the Vatican. Abbas is heading to Rome to attend Francis’ canonization Sunday of two new saints from the Holy Land. The Vatican has been referring unofficially to the state of Palestine for at least a year. During Pope Francis’ 2014 visit to the Holy Land, the Vatican’s official program referred to Abbas as the president of the “state of Palestine.” In the Vatican’s latest yearbook, the Palestinian ambassador to the Holy See is listed as representing “Palestine (state of).” –*NewsMax* (5/13/15). Ed. Pope Francis is certainly making his presence felt in the world!

GIRL SCOUTS NO ACCEPT BOYS WHO CLAIM TO BE BOYS.

A new Girl Scouts of America (GSA) policy states it will extend membership to boys who identify as girls. The group says on its website, “If the child is recognized by the family and school/community as a girl and lives culturally as a girl, then Girl Scouts is an organization that can serve her in a setting that is both emotionally and physically safe.” This means girls in the organization will be forced to recognize and accept transgenderism as a normal lifestyle. Boys in skirts, boys in make-up and boys in tents will become a part of the program. This change will put young innocent girls at risk. Adults are willing to experiment on our kids - both the boys who are confused and the girls who will wonder why a boy in a dress is in the bathroom with them. The

Girl Scouts of America has lost its moral compass and needs your encouragement to rescind this new policy. Since 2003, bad policies like this have resulted in GSA’s enrollment dropping by over one million girls, almost 27% of its membership. –*AFA* (5/15/15). Ed. This is just one more indication that this country has lost any sense of morality. For a boy say he is a girl (or for a girl to say she is a boy) is ludicrous and for his parents and other adults to agree with him (or her) is madness.

MUSLIM POPULATION TO EQUAL CHRISTIANS BY 2050.

{Christian here stands for all kinds}. Muslims will come close to equaling Christians world wide by 2050 while Christians in the United States will decline to two-thirds of the population, a major study by the Pew Research Center has found. A number of studies, including a survey released in March by the Barna Group, found that Christians in the U.S. are indeed on the decline at the expense of the growing numbers of “nones.” The Barna study found that one in four adults in the United States now identifies as atheist or agnostic... Pew’s detailed report published online and coming in at 245 pages, found that in 2010, Christians made up 31 percent of the world’s population, with 2.2 billion adherents. Islam was identified as the second largest religion with 1.6 billion followers. Projections show, however by 2959 Muslims are expected to increase in numbers by 73 percent. If the trend stays true Muslims will make up 2.8 billion or 30 percent of the world’s population while Christianity will have 2.9 billion followers or 31 percent of the total. In terms of fertility rates, Muslims have the highest at 3.1 children per woman while Christians see 2.7 children per woman. *Sword of the Lord* (5/8/15)

AMERICA RATHER HAVE “GAY” PRESIDENT THAT AN EVANGELICAL ONE.

According to the Wall Street Journal/NBC poll 52% of Americans would be comfortable or enthusiastic with an evangelical Christian president – up from 41% in 2006. However the percentage of Americans that would be comfortable or enthusiastic with a homosexual president shot up 18% from 43% to 61% now. Dr. Alex McFarland, co-host of American Family Radio’s Exploring the World program ... said, “Christianity – and even America itself – is dependent on there being moral values. The “gay” agenda is dependent upon there being no moral values” McFarland contends that the moral fabric of America has been torn – a reality that has been experienced in our schools, media, entertainment industry and the White House... *OneNewsNow* (5/21/15)

SIGHTS I CAN NEVER FORGET

Sir James V. Simpson, M.D. (the Discoverer of Chloroform) said: “When I was a boy I saw a sight I can never forget - a man tied to a cart and dragged, before the people's eyes, through the streets of my native town, his back torn and bleeding from the lash. It was a shameful punishment. For many offences? No, for one offense. Did any of the townsmen offer to divide the lashes with him? No, he who committed the offense bore the penalty all alone. It was the penalty of human law. When I was a student at university I saw another sight I never can forget - a man brought out to die. His arms were pinioned, his face was already as pale as death - thousands of eager eyes were upon him as he came from jail. Did any man ask to die in his room? Did any friend come and loose the rope, and say, ‘Put it around my neck, I will die instead?’ No, he underwent the sentence of the law. For many offences? No, for one offense. He had stolen a money parcel from a stagecoach. He broke the law at one point and he died for it. I saw another sight - myself a sinner standing on the brink of ruin, deserving naught but hell. For one sin? No, for many, many sins committed against the unchanging laws of God. But again I looked, and saw Jesus, my Substitute scourged in my stead, and dying on the cross for me. I looked, and cried, and was forgiven.” **“For He hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him.”** Have you trusted Jesus Christ as your Savior from sin? Why not do it right now?
