



HILLARY SAYS RELIGION MUST ADAPT TO MODERN VIEWS

Of course, religion can and does change. By-and-large people want religion according to their own particular philosophies and desires. And the so called clergy are only too happy to accommodate them in most cases. There is an example in Isaiah 30:10: **“Which say to the seers, See not; and to the prophets, Prophecy not unto us right things, speak unto us smooth things, prophecy deceits.”** The plain truth of God was too hard for them - it was repent of your sins and obey God. They would rather have a comfortable “deceit” - a lie that would make them feel comfortable would be more acceptable than the truth which would save their souls. You find a similar passage in Jeremiah 5:30,31. **“A wonderful and horrible thing is committed in the land; The prophets prophecy falsely, and the priests bear rule by their means; and my people love to have it so: and what will ye do in the end thereof?”** Note, the people were really happy with a false message that could not help them. Read Jeremiah, there were plenty of prophets who gave the people just what they wanted while Jeremiah told them the truth: Unless you repent judgment is coming! But the people were not up to repentance and surrender to God. Every time I read Jeremiah I think, who was right and who was wrong. The people had the majority on their side, but the majority was wrong. A pleasant message did not do anything to turn away the truth!

Yes, religion does and will continue to change. Many church leaders will continue to tell the people what they want to hear. But men don’t have to answer to religion but unto God. God’s Word declares: **“Forever, O Lord, thy Word is settled in heaven.”** ~Psalm 119:89. While men tamper with the Word of God (a very dangerous pastime) They cannot really change what God has given. God has promised to preserve His Word forever. He has done so thus far and He will continue to do so. Psalm 12:6,7 **“The Words of the Lord are pure words: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times. Thou shalt keep them, O LORD, Thou shalt preserve them from this generation forever.”** What about you my Friend? You are going to give account, not to some religious leader but unto God! The Bible says, **“All have sinned, and come short of the glory of God.”** But praise the Lord Jesus Christ, God’s Son, came into this world and died for your sins.
