In Luke 8:22-25 you have an incident where the disciples are out in a boat and Jesus is asleep in the boat. A storm soon arose and the boat was taking on water so that they thought it would sink. Feeling they were about to perish, the disciples awakened Him and He calmed the storm. Then, He said unto them: **"Where is your faith?"** Child of God, it is impossible to go through this world without storms - without trials, difficulty and opposition. And yet, most of us act as though there is something wrong if everything is not tranquil and just to our liking. Now, we need faith in the "good" days, but we especially need it in the "bad" days. EVOLUTIONIST SPEAKS OUT AGAINST

EVOLUTION - The following is from Creation Moments.com, Mar. 25, 2015: “Meet Wolf-Ekkehard Lönnig, a brilliant scientist who worked at the Max-Planck Institute until his retirement. Though he has written four books on the subject of evolution, he has infuriated evolutionists everywhere by daring to challenge Neo-Darwinism on scientific grounds. He told the *Diplomacy Post* in March 2014: ‘A scientific hypothesis should be potentially falsifiable.... However,’ he added, ‘the idea of slow evolution by “infinitesimally small inherited variations, etc. has been falsified by the findings of paleontology ... as well [as] genetics. Yet its adherents principally reject any scientific proof against Neo-Darwinism,’ he said, ‘so that, in fact, their theory has become a non-falsifiable worldview, to which people stick in spite of all contrary evidence.’ Scientists continue to support evolution despite the evidence that actually falsified evolution because ‘without Darwinism, philosophic materialism has lost its battle against an intelligent origin of the world.’ But Wolf had more to say. ‘According to Neo-Darwinism, all important problems of the origin of species are, at least in principle, solved. Further questions on the validity of evolutionary theory are thus basically superfluous. However, such a dogmatic attitude stops further investigations and hinders fruitful research in science.’ Though Wolf-Ekkehard Lönnig has stopped short of giving recognition to God as the Intelligent Designer, we applaud his work for showing that evolution doesn’t even deserve to be called scientific.” – FBIS (8/21/15)

THE POPE’S LATEST SURPRISE! Pope Francis will give all priests discretion to formally forgive women who have had abortions during the Roman Catholic Church’s upcoming Holy Year, in the Argentine pontiff’s latest move towards a more open and inclusive church. In Church teaching, abortion is such a grave sin that those who procure or perform it incur an automatic excommunication. Usually only designated clergy and missionaries can formally forgive abortions. But from Dec.8 to Nov. 26, during an extraordinary Holy Year or “Jubilee” on the theme of mercy announced by Pope Francis in March, all priests will be able to do so, he said in a letter published on Tuesday by the Vatican. In the letter, Francis described the “existential and moral ordeal” faced by women who have terminated pregnancies and said he had “met so many women who bear in their heart the scar of this agonizing and painful decision”. Francis is the first non-European pope in 1,300 years and has also marked himself out for his tolerance regarding taboo topics. In a remark that has become emblematic of his

papacy, he asked “who am I to judge?” with regard to a gay person who seeks God. –AOL News (9/1/15). Ed. There are those who tell us that the Roman Catholic Church doesn’t change. EGYPTIAN CHRISTIAN IMPRISONED FOR HANDING OUT BIBLES

The following is excerpted from “Egyptian Christian,” ChristianHeadlines.com, Aug. 28, 2015: “A 35-year-old Egyptian Christian is likely to remain in jail for one to five years for handing out Bibles in a shopping mall. The Christian Post reports Medhat Ishak was caught handing out Bibles in Oct. 6 last year. He was sentenced to 15 days in jail for ‘inciting sectarian strife’ and ‘harming national security.’ However, a judge has now slapped Ishak with a heftier charge--blasphemy. The Christian man now faces a sentence between one and five years in prison for ‘insulting religion,’ though his lawyers argue Ishak did not commit the offense. According to attorney Rafik Rafaat, Ishak did encounter a Muslim man at the mall, though he did not know he was Muslim at first. Ishak offered him a Bible and when the man refused and explained that the was a Muslim, Ishak apologized and left.” -Copied

IRAN’S SUPREME LEADER SAYS ISRAEL WILL BE DEAD WITHIN 25 YEARS

Iran’s Supreme Leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei said this week that Israel will not survive another 25 years (“Iran Deal,” Breitbart, Sept. 9, 2015). On Twitter, Khamenei said, “God willing, there will be nothing as Zionist regime by next 25 years.” Khamenei is a big user of Twitter. November 8, 2014, he tweeted, “This barbaric, wolflike & infanticidal regime of Israel which spares no crime has no cure but to be annihilated.” In an address to an assembly of tens of thousands of Basij militiamen in November 2013, Khamenei declared that Israel was doomed to fail and characterized the “Zionist regime” as the “sinister, unclean rabid dog of the region.” He said Israelis “cannot be called human beings.” Footage of the event showed the crowd shouting “Death to America” and “Death to Israel.” In an address in Tehran in September of this year, General Moshen Kazzemeinni said, “The Islamic Revolution will continue enhancing its preparedness until it overthrows Israel and liberates Palestine” (“Commander: Iran Continues Military Enhancement until Collapse of Israel,” Fars News Agency, Sep. 2, 2015). It doesn’t matter how good you think you are, if you are not born again, regenerated, you cannot see the Kingdom of God!” Jesus said **“Ye must be born again,”** and that’s all there is to it! Have you been born again, regenerated? If not, you’ll not see Heaven. Repent of your sins and ask Christ to save you. **“Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and thou shalt be saved.”**
