President Reagan's remarks on lighting the National Christmas Tree, Dec. 12, 1985. - From Legal Alert (12/06).

"My fellow Americans, thank you for joining Nancy and me on this festive evening. The menorah stands lighted in Lafayette Park, for this is also the time of Hanukkah, and this season is rich in the meaning of our Judeo-Christian tradition. In a moment we'll be lighting the National Christmas Tree, carrying forward what is now a 62-year tradition first begun by Calvin Coolidge. Tonight we are drawn in warmth to one another as we reflect on the deeply holy meaning of the miracle we shall soon celebrate. We know that Mary and Joseph reached the stable in Bethlehem sometime after sunset. We do not know the exact moment the Christ Child was born... Suddenly, a star from Heaven shining in our eyes, shining with brilliant beauty across the skies, a star pointing toward eternity in the night, like a great ring of pure and endless light, and then all was calm and all was bright. Such was the beginning of one solitary life that would shake the world as never before or since. When we speak of Jesus and of His life, we speak of a man revered as a prophet and a teacher by people of all religions, and Christians speak of someone greater -- a man who was and is divine. He brought forth a power that is infinite and a promise that is eternal, a power greater than all man's military might, for His power is Godly love, love that can lift our sorrows and heal our wounds and drive away our fears. He promised there would never be a long night that does not end. He promised to deliver us from dark torment and tragedy into the warming sunlight of human happiness, and beyond that, into paradise. He has never been a halfway giver; His generosity is pure and perfect and sure.

This, then expresses the true meaning of Christmas. If each of us would give but a fraction to each other of what He gave to the whole human family, how many hearts would heal, how much sorrow and pain could be driven away? There's still time for joy and gladness to touch a sad and lonely soul, still time to feed a hungry child, to wrap a present for a kind old man feeling forlorn and afraid, and to reach out to an abandoned mother raising children on her own. There's still time to remember our Armed Forces, to express our profound gratitude to those who keep watch on faraway frontiers of freedom... They are not and never will be forgotten. And there is still time to remember the deepest truth of all: that there can be no prisons, no walls, no boundaries separating the members of God's family. Let us reach out tonight to every person who is persecuted; let us embrace and comfort, support and love them. Let us come together as one family under the Fatherhood of God, binding ourselves in a communion of hearts... May we give thanks for an America abundantly blessed, for a nation united, free, and at peace. May we carry forward the happiness of the Christmas spirit as the guiding star of our endeavors 365 days a year. As we light this magnificent tree, may all the youthful hope and joy of America light up the heavens and make the angels sing. Merry Christmas, God bless you all. And now we are going to light the tree." (Ed. Note, it was not a Holiday Tree).

Ed. We'd not agree with every statement above, but it shows that only a few years ago Christianity was permissible in public life. Can you imagine a public official speaking like that today, when Christ, Christmas and everything related to Christianity is being banished from public life? The Constitution doesn't require hostility to Christianity!

NEWS YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT

HARVARD PROF ON HOW LIBERALS SHOULD TREAT CONSERVATIVES.

A Harvard law professor has proposed dealing with what he calls conservative “losers in the culture wars” with a hard line similar to what was done to Germany and Japan after World War II. His suggestion comes in a blog post at [Balkanization](#) outlining what he says should be an abrupt change in mindset of liberal thinkers to finally abandon “defensive-crouch constitutionalism” in a desire to shape the courts and their rulings. Prof. Mark Tushnet says now that the courts are dominated by those appointed by Democratic presidents, it is time for judges to stop worrying about reversal by the Supreme Court if they take aggressively liberal positions. In the blog post, Tushnet, one of the more controversial figures in constitutional theory, writes: “For liberals, the question now is how to deal with the losers in the culture wars... My own judgment is that taking a hard line (“You lost, live with it”) is better than trying to accommodate the losers, who — remember — defended, and are defending, positions that liberals regard as having no normative pull at all. “Trying to be nice to the losers didn’t work well after the Civil War, nor after Brown (And taking a hard line seemed to work reasonably well in Germany and Japan after 1945).” NewsMax (5/12/16) Ed. Harvard is the epitome of liberal thought. The campus is less than five miles from our Church. They like compromise until they come into the dominant place.

OBAMA ADMINISTRATION ORDERS PUBLIC SCHOOL BATHROOMS BE OPEN TO TRANSGENDERS.

The Obama administration on Friday ordered every public school district in the United States to allow transgender students to use the bathrooms that match the gender identity they have chosen. “No student should ever have to go through the experience of feeling unwelcome at school or on a college campus,” Education Secretary John King Jr. [told The New York Times in a statement late Thursday.](#) “We must ensure that our young people know that whoever they are or wherever they come from, they have the opportunity to get a great education in an environment free from discrimination, harassment and violence.” “There is no room in our schools for discrimination of any kind, including discrimination against transgender students on the basis of their sex,” Attorney General Loretta Lynch said in a statement accompanying the directive. The order, signed by the Education and Justice departments, describes what school districts should do to ensure that no students are

discriminated against. It will not have the force of law, but carries an implicit threat: Schools not abiding by the Obama administration’s interpretation of the law could face lawsuits or a loss of federal aid. The decree comes amid the administration’s battle with North Carolina over transgender rights and is most likely to renew attacks by Republicans that the White House is involving itself in state issues. The Justice Department and North Carolina Gov. Pat McCrory sued each other over the transgender bathroom law he signed in March. The law requires transgender people to use the public restroom matching the sex on their birth certificate. The ordinance only applies to schools, universities, government buildings and highway rest stops. NewsMax (5/13/16). Ed. We wonder when God is going to say enough!

TRANSGENDERS IN THE MILITARY.

The Pentagon is four months past one deadline — and looking at months more — to agree on how to move forward with new policies aimed at allowing transgender service members to openly serve, [The Washington Post](#) reports. Disagreements still exist within the Defense Department about how to proceed. “If there was consensus on it, yeah, we would have done it,” Peter Levine told the Washington Post. “But obviously there are different views from different officials in the services.” Levine, the Pentagon’s acting personnel chief, said the goal is to get it done “in this administration,” meaning President Obama’s second and final, which puts Defense Secretary Ashton Carter on the clock. Waiting in the balance are an estimated 12,800 transgender military members, according to the Palm Center, an independent think tank. One major issue, among many, at the center of disagreement between military branches is how long should a transgender service member wait post-transition before being allowed to join the military. The Army and Marine Corps advocated 24 months while the Navy and Air Force thought 12 months was sufficient, according to the Post. NewsMax (5/16/16)

A PARDON THAT DID NO GOOD

Over one hundred and fifty years ago in Pennsylvania a man was convicted of murder while committing a train robbery. Back in those days the country was a little more interested in law and order than today; he was sentenced to die. But there was an appeal made to Andrew Jackson, President of United States. Jackson granted the guilty man, George Wilson, a pardon. But Wilson refused to receive it. He said that he wanted to die and argued that he wasn't pardoned until he accepted it and this he refused to do. Nothing like this had ever happened before. Who ever heard of a murderer refusing a pardon? The State's attorney said the law was silent on that so, it was taken to the U.S. Supreme Court. The celebrated John Marshall, Chief Justice, handed down this decision: "*A pardon is just a piece of paper unless it is accepted by the person which is implicated. If he refuses the pardon, then, it is not a pardon. George Wilson must hang.*" And he was hanged! Over 2,000 years ago the Son of God, Jesus Christ, died on the cross to pay for the sins of the world, *for your sins*, and because of that fact, God offers you a pardon. **"In whom (Christ) we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins."** ~Colossians 1:14. Will you receive God's wonderful offer? God says, **"As many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name."** You don't have to reject this pardon like George Wilson did - all you have to do is neglect it. Refuse to take it. The Bible warns: **"How shall we escape if we neglect so great salvation."** Receive Christ and His pardon right now!
